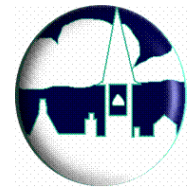
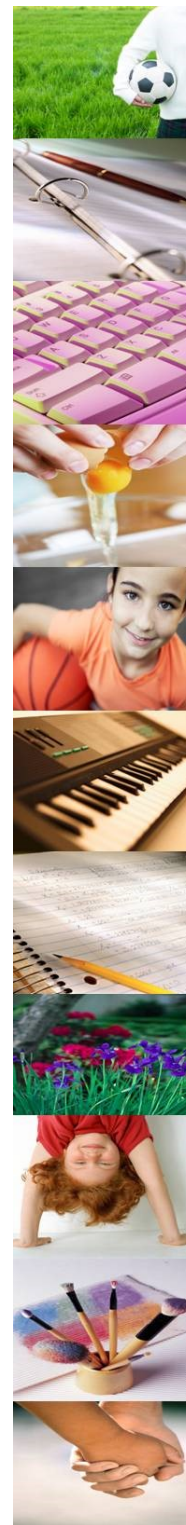
We will continue to inform parents of the school's progress with our development plan.

We want to make sure everyone feels safe and happy at our school. We want children, staff and parents to feel valued and listened to. We will link our work to our continuing RRSA journey.



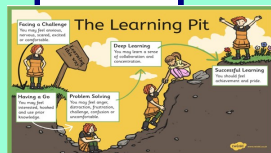
What are we doing to improve our school this year? 2020-21?
