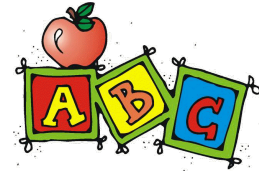


P3/4 Newsletter

Welcome to Primary 3/4 at Glenbervie School. We hope you all had a lovely summer break and are ready for the excitement and challenges of Primary 3/4! We thought it would be helpful to share with you some of our routines, ways of working and what we have planned for the term ahead.

Literacy

Spelling will start in week 2 - P3 the first 3 weeks are revision of previous sounds, P4 - they will be starting a new spelling programme. Please support your child by carrying out activities which are at the front of the homework jotter. This term we will be doing a book study rather than sending reading home. The class will be using the 'Lighthouse Keeper' book to support their language development. We would really appreciate it if parents could continue to read to their children a wide range of text.



Numeracy



We will be starting the term by looking at money and how we use it in our daily life. Parents can support by practicing using money at home - play shoppies. The class will also be working on their addition skills. Parents could practice number bonds to 10, 20 - these will help with addition with 100 and above.

Topic

This term we are carrying out various exciting activities through theme of Seashore.

Seesaw

Again this year we will continue to use the Seesaw app to create online learning profiles. Please check in regularly to see what we have been up to in class likes and comments are a great way to encourage the children in their learning. New QR codes are in the front of homework diaries, any problems please contact the school.

Equipment

Gym Kits - Gym kits (indoor + outdoor) are required every Monday and Friday.

Forest School - P3/4 will have Forest School every second Tuesday, an email will be sent when equipment is required.

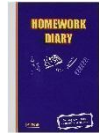
Please also practice using cutlery at home as we only have one adult in the hall at lunchtimes.
