

Term 3 January to March 2024 (P1/2/3)

This curricular letter aims to share with you the key learning which your child will engage with in term 3.

Our topics will be Through the Decades and Where the Wild Things Are! Through the Decades will be an interdisciplinary topic in which we explore key events in our history, music, dance and technology whilst comparing life in the past to the present day. Where the Wild things are, will take place in the second half of the term. This will be a science based topic in which we will learn about plant growth, habitats and food chains. We will be making a comparison between plants and wildlife found in Scotland and in the Rainforest.

Additionally, P1/2/3 will be working together to organise and run a community café this term. Here we will have the opportunity to develop skills in food technology.

In Literacy, we will be learning Scots poetry and developing our presentation skills. Our writing focus this term will be functional (letters and posters) and imaginative story writing.

In maths, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction within 10, 20 and 100. Additionally we will be learning about symmetry and measure.
